TF-CBT Learning Community for Massachusetts Therapists

This no-cost training and TF-CBT (Trauma-Focused Cognitive Behavioral Therapy) Learning Community is intended for all **CBHC**, **CMHC**, **CBHI & BHHL**-affiliated therapists possessing a master's or doctoral degree in a mental health profession who provide therapy to children impacted by trauma.

Participants who complete the Learning Community requirements will be eligible to pursue National Certification in TF-CBT.

Why TF-CBT?

TF-CBT is the most well-supported, evidence-based treatment for youth who have experienced trauma or traumatic grief and who have clinically significant problems as a result.

TF-CBT is a structured, short-term treatment model that can be implemented in 8-25 sessions with the youth and their caregiver.

Through this Learning Community, clinicians will learn to deliver TF-CBT with fidelity to the model from Nationally Accredited TF-CBT Trainers Jessica Griffin, PsyD, Jessica Wozniak, PsyD, & Deidre Hussey, PsyD.

Requirements

- Complete Online Training *prerequisite* due two weeks prior to Basic Training (complimentary code provided after Learning Community registration)
- Three half-day live virtual Basic Training
- Nine out of 12 one-hour TF-CBT Consultation video calls required, across the Learning Community timeline
- Utilization of TF-CBT with one youth at all times, aiming for a total of three throughout the calls
- Completion of formal case presentation and one full case completion by the end of the consultation
- 6 Mental health providers are affiliated with one of the above MA-based provider networks


